* For students to complete their major within the prescribed unit requirement (typically 120 units), students with lower-division GE Area D credit could complete upper-division GE Synthesis courses HST 3340 and/or PLS 4205 to satisfy the American Institutions (AI) requirement Part A and/or Part B, respectively. Students majoring in programs with unrestricted elective units are strongly encouraged to complete HST 2201 or HST 2202 to satisfy AI requirement Part A, and/or PLS 2010 to satisfy AI requirement Part B.
